



2. PRE-ADHESION STAGES AND EC SUPPORT

Adhesion Preparation – 3 phases

Goal- increase a political dialogue or know each better

- Stabilization Association Agreement (SAA)-a process to become closer to EU conditions, includes economic and social principles.
- EU partnership, twining and National Program for adoption of the acquis
- EC Instrument of Pre-Accession Assistance (IPA)- 11,5 Billion euro for 2007-2013. For the Western Balkans it is estimated at 500 million per year.







L'ACQUIS- 35 Chapters

- The 35 chapters are part of overall negotiation process for EU Adhesion
- Chapters 1-4 (goods, labour, services, capital) pillars of the EU Internal market
- Other selected chapters:

Internal Market Creation

• The creation of the internal market- one of the corner stones of EU (Chap-1-4)

Goal- establish a common area with common values where exist a free movement of production factors, i.e. goods, labor, services and capital)


- The overall IM process is gradual and has not finished yet. It requires a strong harmonization of laws and regulations and high internal coordination.
- Free movement of goods is one of the most advanced elements. It implies a reduction of technical barriers to trade in industrial products, i.e.
- Improvement and harmonization of standards and certification procedures
- Protection of intellectual and industrial property rights (IPR)
- Opening of **public procurement** to IM competition: publication in the OJEC
- Contracts over 5 ml euro for Pub. works; Pub. supplies (hospital equip., R&D, schools, others) for 200.000 eu; also water, energy, transport & telecom sectors.

Approaching the EU-open adhesion negotiations

- Croatia- in October 2005. 22 chapters open and 7 preliminary close
- Turkey- in October 2005. 10 chapters open and 1 preliminary close
- Macedonia- Candidate since December 2005. No chapter open
- Montenegro- Presented candidacy 15 December 2008
- Other Balkan countries:

ernational Services

- Albania-SAA signed June 2006
- Bosnia & Herzegovina-SAA signed June 2008
- Kosovo-Consideration on a possible specific accord. (Resolution 1244 UNSC)
- Montenegro- SAA signed October 2007
- Serbia- SAA signed April 2008. SAA under conditions of full cooperation to International Penal Tribunal on the former Yugoslavia







Turkey case- 1964-2008 (44 years)

- 1964 signed a Association Treaty with the EEC
- 1987 presented the application for EU membership (13 year later)
- 1999 the EU recognized Turkey as candidate country (12 year later)
- 2005 EU negotiations started (6 years later and 18 years after application). 10 chapters are open, and one is "preliminary" close.
- The country presents pros and cons among EU member countries:
- **Pros-** Incorporation of EU political and social values, big market, EU influence in neighboring regions, i.e. Balkans, Middle East and Central Asia.
- Cons- "Non-European", big country with different values, historical past
- Two EU members (Au, Fr) will require national referendum on adhesion



IPA-Instrument of Pre-Adhesion Assistance (Financial allocation per habitant per year)







3. THE COPEHANGEN CRITERIES

- Two articles of the Treaty of EU are based for EU Adhesion :
- Art.49. Every European State that respect the principles of the art.6.para 1, can request to become member of the EU
- Art.6.1. Union is based on the principles of freedom, democracy, respect of human rights, rule of law and fundamental liberties, principles that are common to member states.

Criterion:

ernational Services

- 1. Political Criterion-Institution Stability and guaranty of democratic rights. Respect of Human Rights & Rule of Law. Respect & protection of minorities
- 2. Economic Criterion Functioning market economy, capable of support competition from the Union internal market forces
- 3. Adoption and implementation of the acquis communitaire
- 4. Absorption capacity of the EU

Negotiation Mechanism

Who take part in the negotiation process? European Council : Member States, Presidency, SGC European Commission (EC) Candidate Country: Chef and negotiation team, Unit of Inter-Ministerial Coordination

Main Stages of negotiation

Screening- multilateral and bilateral (Concordance Tables)
Screening reports- determination of open criteria for negotiations (yes or no)
Negotiation position of the candidate country
Common position of EU- open chapter and closing criteria
Closing the chapter (preliminary). Revised common position
Follow up commitments on implementation and closing negotiations

SCREENING-Analytic diagnostic

Candidate Provides information on the stage harmonization with the acquis communautaire

DG Enlargement + DG specialized (agri, trade, environment, JLS...)

Commission

- multilateral screening Explain the 35 chapters of the acquis to candidates
- •bilateral screening negotiation specific areas by candidate
- •Screening report publication-one by country and chapter




OPENING-NEGOTIATIONS BY CHAPTER
